From the Deacon's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the gospel for today, Jesus says to Martha, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing." What is this one thing? We have a hint of it in the next line that Jesus says, "Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her." What Jesus doesn't say is that Martha you are wrong, and Mary is right, rather he says that "Mary has chosen the better part". I believe that the first and second readings give a hint to what Jesus is hinting at here. The first reading tells us about the encounter of Abraham with three men whom he demonstrates hospitality. The Fathers of the Church have always considered these three men as the Trinity. Fundamentally what happens is that Abraham has an encounter with God, who promises him a child and God fulfills that promise. The second reading we see St. Paul writing to the Colossians in which he speaks of a mystery that is revealed to those who are humble. This mystery is as he writes, "it is Christ in you". **Do you have Christ in you?** This is the most important point. **Martha welcomed Jesus Christ into their home, but it was Mary who welcomed Jesus Christ into her heart.** How do we welcome Jesus Christ into our hearts? Through the proclamation of the Word of God, who is Jesus Christ himself. God manifested through Jesus Christ his unfathomable love for us, sinners! In accepting this word, knowing that we are sinners, that the we can receive the Holy Spirit within us, the same Holy Spirit of Jesus Christ through which we are able to fulfill our call to love our enemies.

A través de la proclamación de la Palabra de Dios, que es Jesucristo mismo. ¡Dios manifestó a través de Jesucristo su amor insonable para nosotros, los pecadores! 
