## **Financial News:**

\$1,000 was transferred from the Parsonage Fund (rental income) to the operating fund. This amount is included in the total monthly income on the bar graph.

In June we received \$3,000 in memory of Carl and Bernice Gustafson. This donation was designated to operating costs and is included in the total monthly income on the bar graph.

We used \$300 from the "For Those in Need" fund (used at Pastor's discretion).

Pestop sold the business to Adam's Pest control, slightly increasing the cost of their services.

We received our quarterly deposit from American National in the amount of \$1,235.96, of which 1/3 went to the Building and Grounds fund, 1/3 to the council discretionary fund, 1/6 to Lutheran Social Services, and 1/6 to World Hunger.
