Chinese authorities have detained Catholic Bishop Shah Zhumin of Wenzhou, according to a report by AsiaNews. The report said the 58-year-old prelate, whose episcopal appointment was not accepted by the pro-Beijing Chinese Catholic Patriotic Association, was taken by authorities "on vacation" adding that he has been arrested several times since his 2016 appointment to the diocese.

And now for something completely different!

Thirty people were tattooed in the Liebfrauenkirche in Frankfurt on 25 October. The tattoo instruments were blessed at the altar by Br Paulus Terwitte, a Capuchin priest. The event was organised by Markus Breuer, head of Catholic adult education in the Limburg diocese which invited the tattoo artist Silas Becks to do tattoos for free in the famous Frankfurt church. Candidates chose one from eight Christian motifs. "The demand was enormous", Breuer said. We had to turn 200 people away".
