Inaugurated in 2013, the LEF Klima Scholarship Award/Math and LEF Klima Scholarship Award/Science will be given each year to the top graduating math and science students.

The scholarships are named after the late Kari D. Klima, who was instrumental in starting the Laker Educational Foundation (formerly the Prior Lake-Savage Area Educational Foundation).

Kari exemplified the purposes, the ideals and the principles for which the educational foundation stands. She gave unreservedly of her time, her abilities, and her services to promote the interests of the school district and the foundation.

It is befitting to have these \$1,000 scholarships awarded to the top math and science students in her name.

The annual selection will take place by a group of math & science teachers and presented at the award ceremony in June at Prior Lake High School.

Featured Grant

The following is just one example of how our Foundation gives back to the students in the community.

"E-Books for the Media Center"

Robin Gunning, Media Specialist at Prior Lake High School was recently awarded this grant.



Using the ebooks on an iPad

Robin submitted the following project summary: The high school media center is moving towards a digital based teaching and learning environment. A major component will be adding an eBook collection of reference materials. Many eBooks are interactive and provide additional online links and suggested alternative subjects. PLHS is moving forward with students having access anywhere through a variety of devices. eBooks allow the students 365/24/7 access wherever they have an internet connection.

How will the books be chosen?

The selection of eBooks will be done by collaborating with the teachers on what they need to meet the curriculum needs. When a department is up for adoption, we will work with them to find new resources to fit with the new curriculum. If a community education class is offered that can take advantage of the media center resources, they will be given the passwords to access them and a tutorial will be provided when needed.

Comments from Assistant Principal:

"We live in a digital world. The method used by students to do research and collect information looks completely different than it did as little as ten years ago. We need to move forward with this 21st century form of teaching and learning. It is imperative that we provide all of our students the resources they need to be successful."

Comments from Media Specialist Robin Gunning:

We are up and running! At present we have 106 eBooks in our collection with more on order. The majority are non-fiction with a small collection of classic literature. All the books can be accessed by multiple users at the same time. Access to the school's eBooks, checking out eBooks, and reading online or offline is available for hand held devices and home computers. All the information is on the Media Center web page. Thank you to Laker Educational Foundation for rewarding us the grant for eBooks.
