4. The step-by-step lesson plans are easy to follow, and we have all the materials and instruments that you'll need right in the Music Room (C7). You'll also have online access to the Music Room Calendar and all the lesson materials.

5. For Kindergarten through 3rd Grade, no special training or knowledge of music is required. All you need is a love of music and a willingness to share it.

6. For 4th & 5th Grades, it helps to have some background in music (i.e. piano lessons, guitar, band, choir, etc.), but no formal training is required.
