The Gospel of this Sunday brings to us the story of Lazarus the beggar and the Rich Man. We might think that this story is about money and rich vs. poor or class struggle but it is not. The center of the Gospel is that not even if a dead man rose from death people will believe if they are not willing to listen to God and the people He sends. God has given us Moses and Prophets in his Scriptures, in the Teaching of the Church but are we listening to it or just picking and choosing what we like and what we don't like? Here is the heart, do you believe the voice of God through His Church on issues of Respect Life (Being that October is the Respect Life Month) like abortion, or issues like marriage as a indissoluble sacrament between man and a woman. Because if we do not listen to the voice of God that he manifests Himself through His Church then how can we put our hearts in God and let ourselves be guided completely by Him. So, I invite you to know better the teaching of the Church through the Catechism and through the Scriptures and the Teaching of the Pope.



I am also publishing today the annual financial statement of the parish. I invite you to read it and also to read the explanation in the back.
