The Bible Memory Game

Goal:

• To memorize the scriptures on the cards.

Assembly:

Print off a copy of each page. If you can, print on cardstock.

Print off four copies of the Memory Game back (the ones with the menorah).

Cut out all the squares.

Paste one of the cards with the menorah to the back of each card.

If you have a laminating machine or lamination sheets, you can laminate the cards so that they will last longer.

Instructions:

- 1. Mix up the cards and lay them in rows on a flat surface (Menorah side up).
- 2. Turn over any two cards, one at a time.
- 3. If the pictures don't match, turn them back over. It is the next turn.
- 4. If the pictures do match, make sure to read both cards out loud. This will help you to remember the scripture, and where it is found in the Bible. Pick them up and set them to the side.
- 5. Continue taking turns until no more cards remain.
