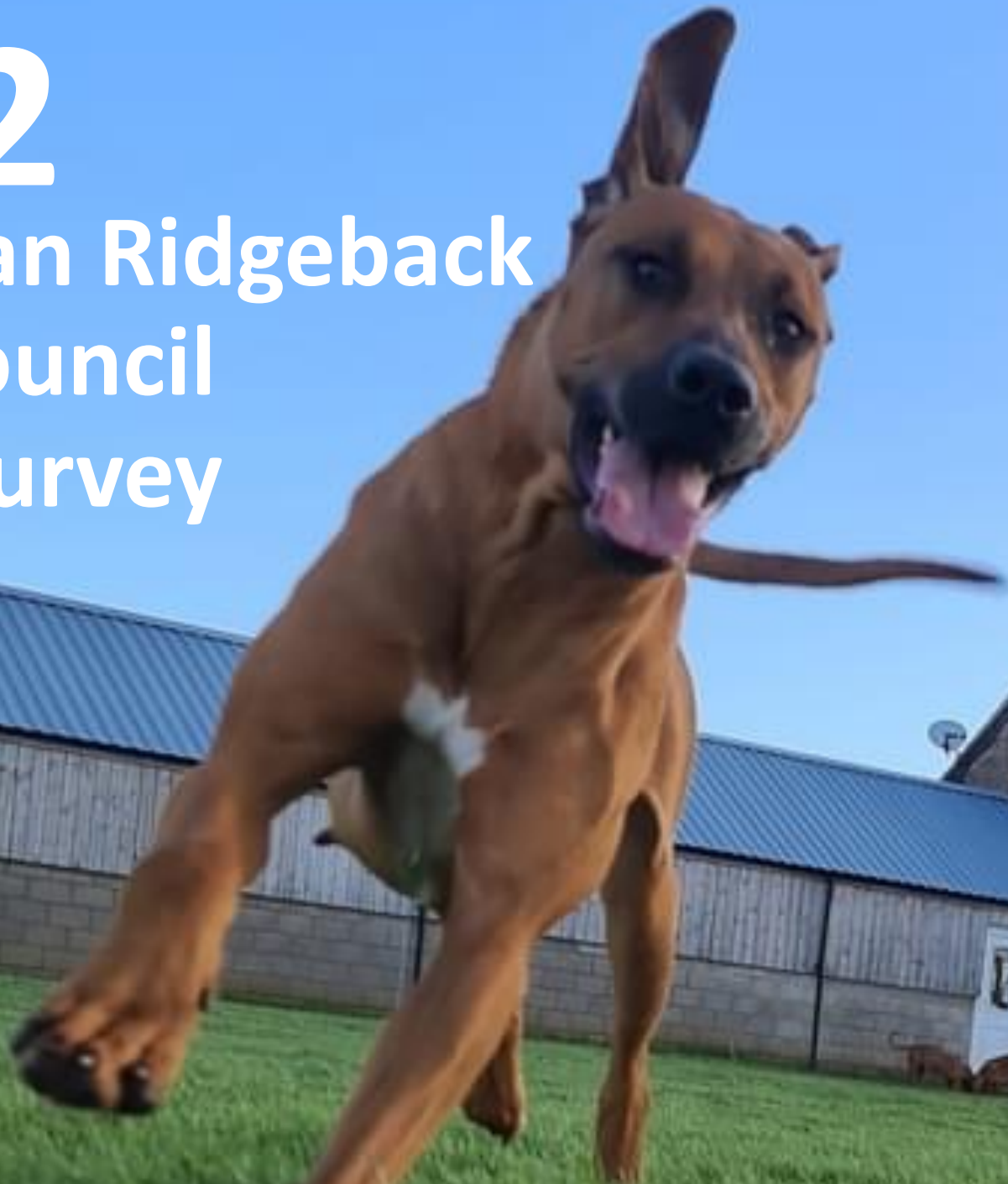

# What was the aim of the Health Survey?

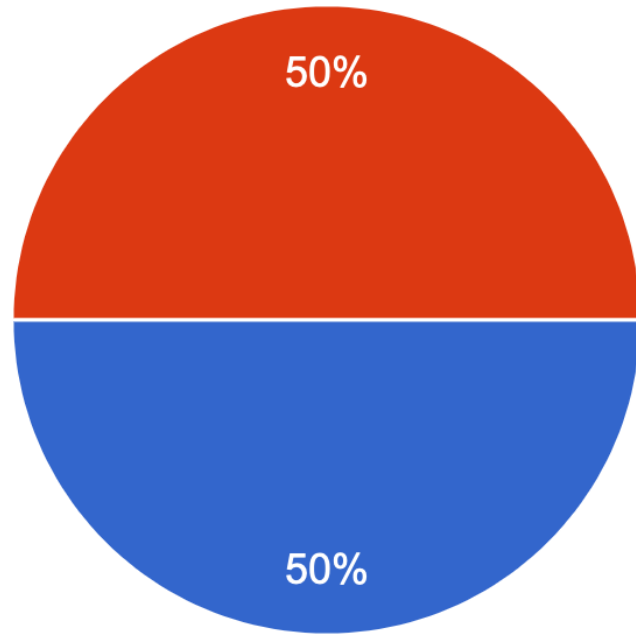
- To gather information about Rhodesian Ridgebacks in the UK which will assist and enable the formulation of future Health Plans.
- The statistical information can be, if required, supplied to the KC to help in the production of The Breed Health and Conservation Plan.

# How successful was the Health Survey?

- A total of 734 responses were received for individual dogs.
- Approximately 430 individual owners responded to the Health Survey.
- Responses came from a mixture of Breeders and Pet Owners.

# Is your Rhodesian Ridgeback a Dog or a Bitch?

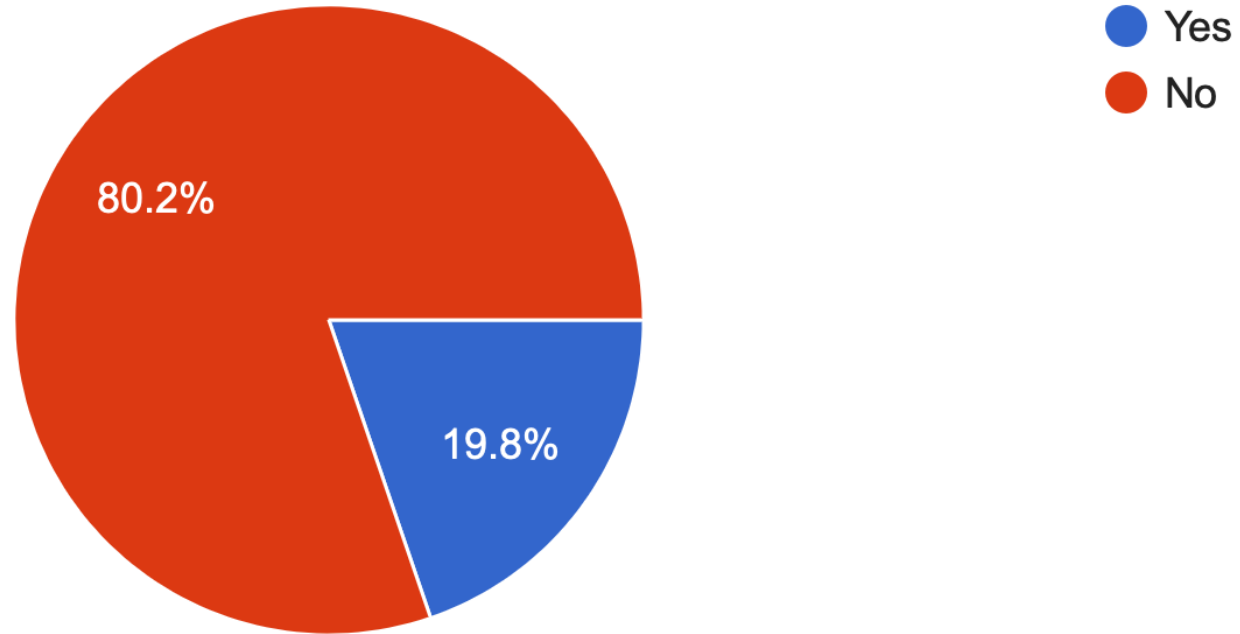

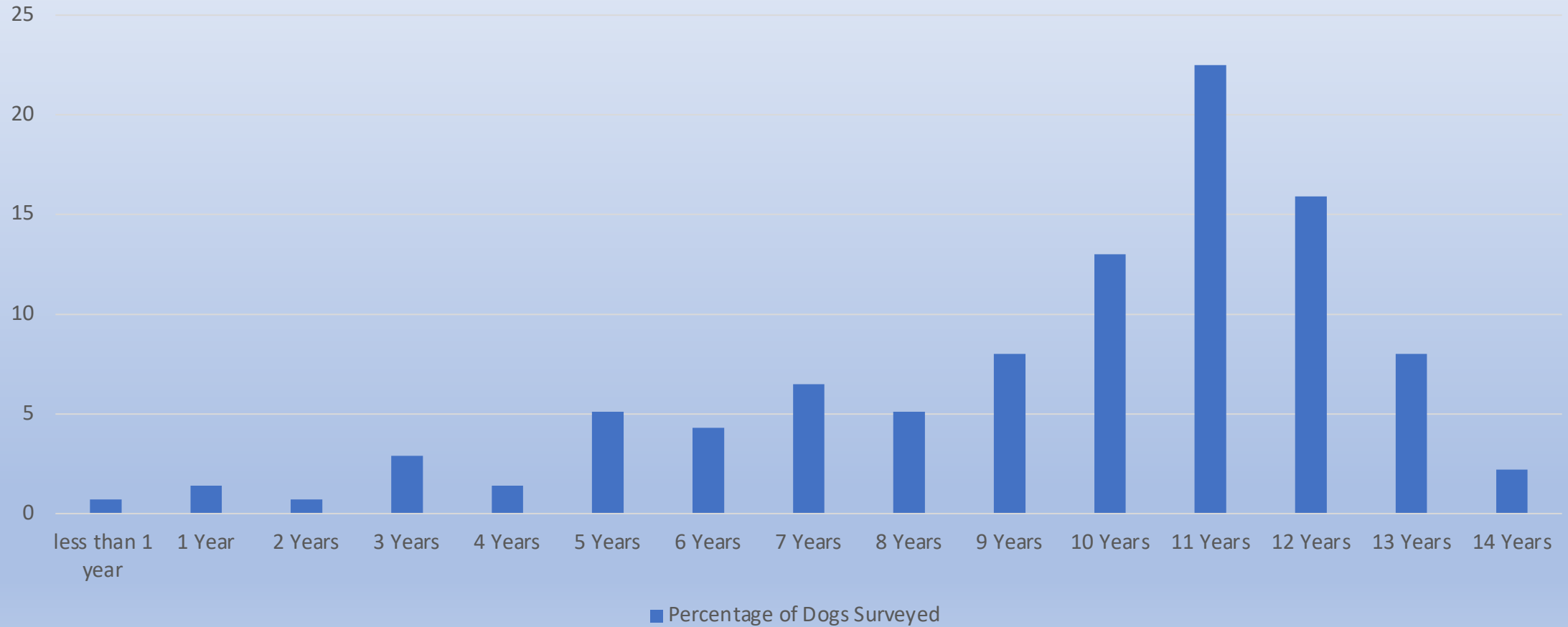

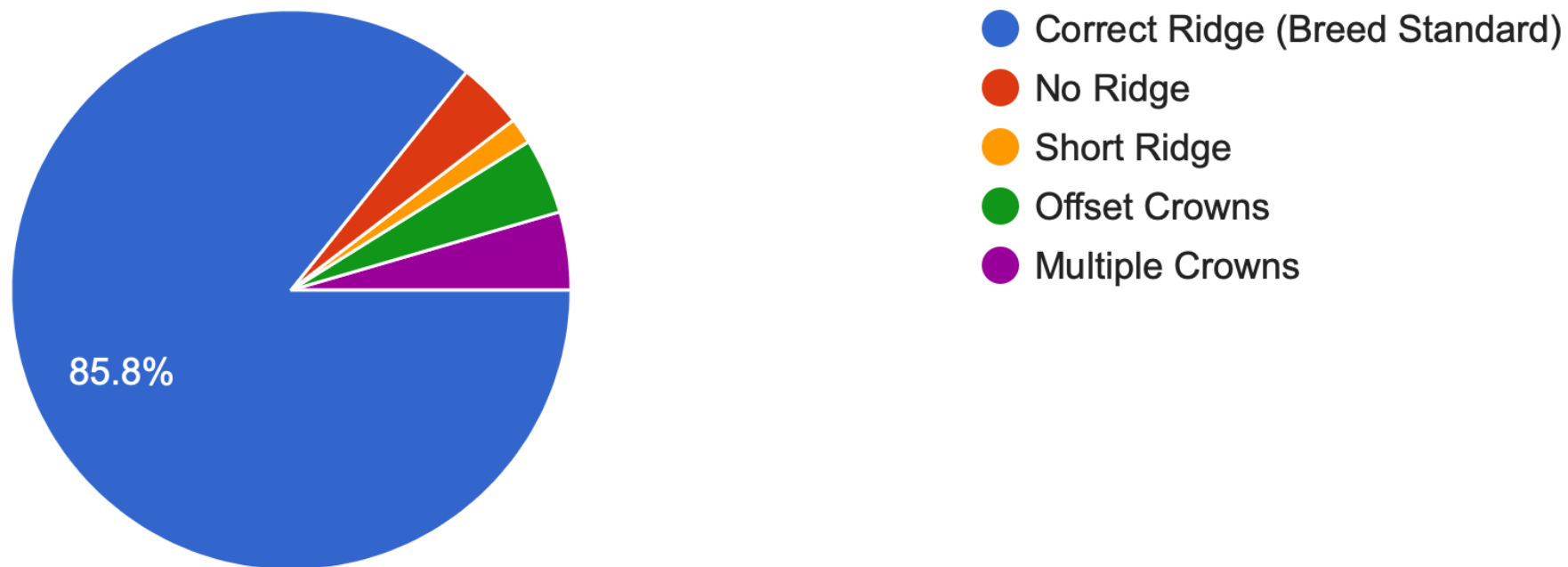


# If your Rhodesian Ridgeback has passed away how old were they when they died?



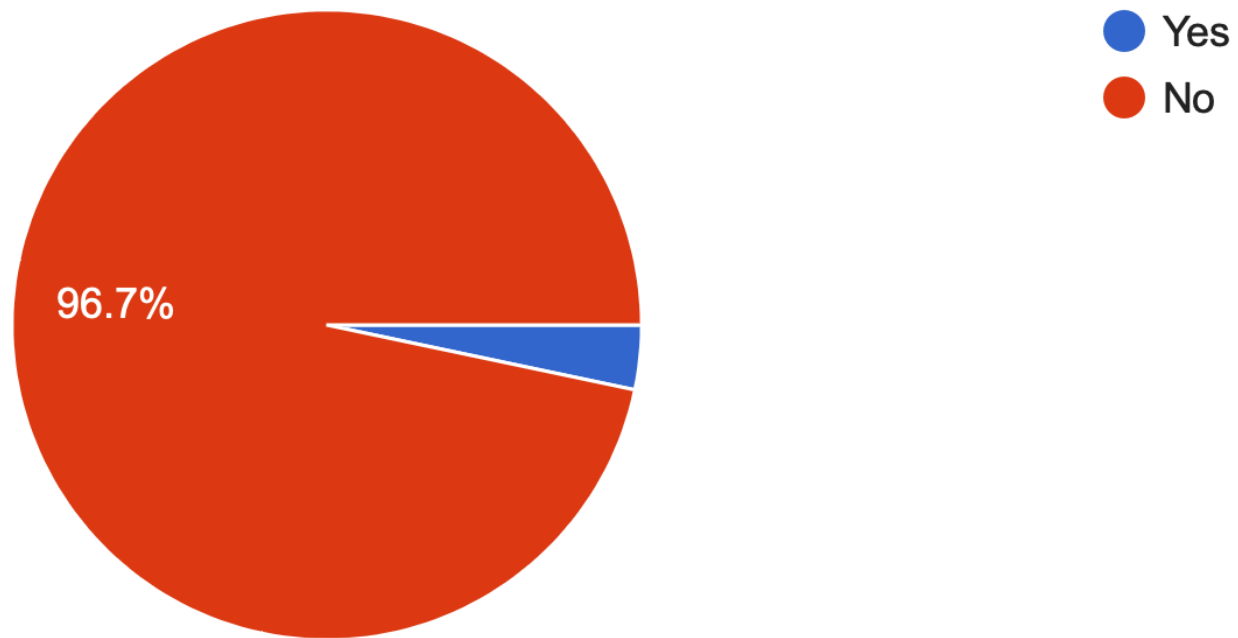
## Which of the following would best describe your Rhodesian Ridgebacks Ridge?

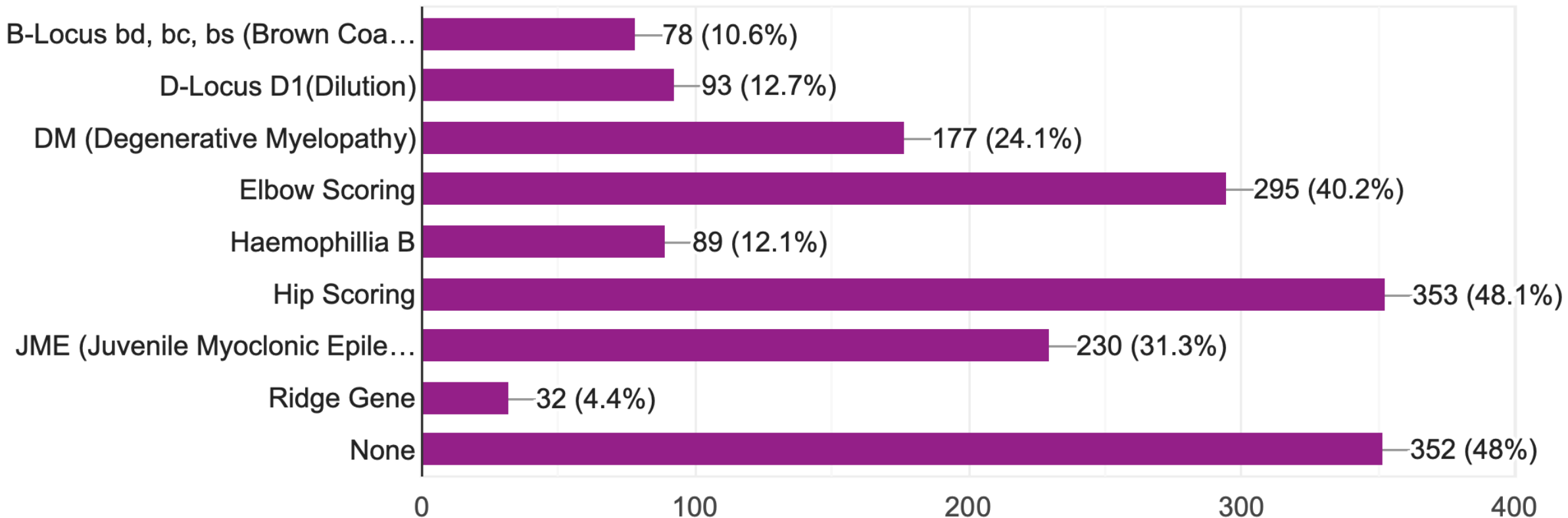
# Dermoid Sinus

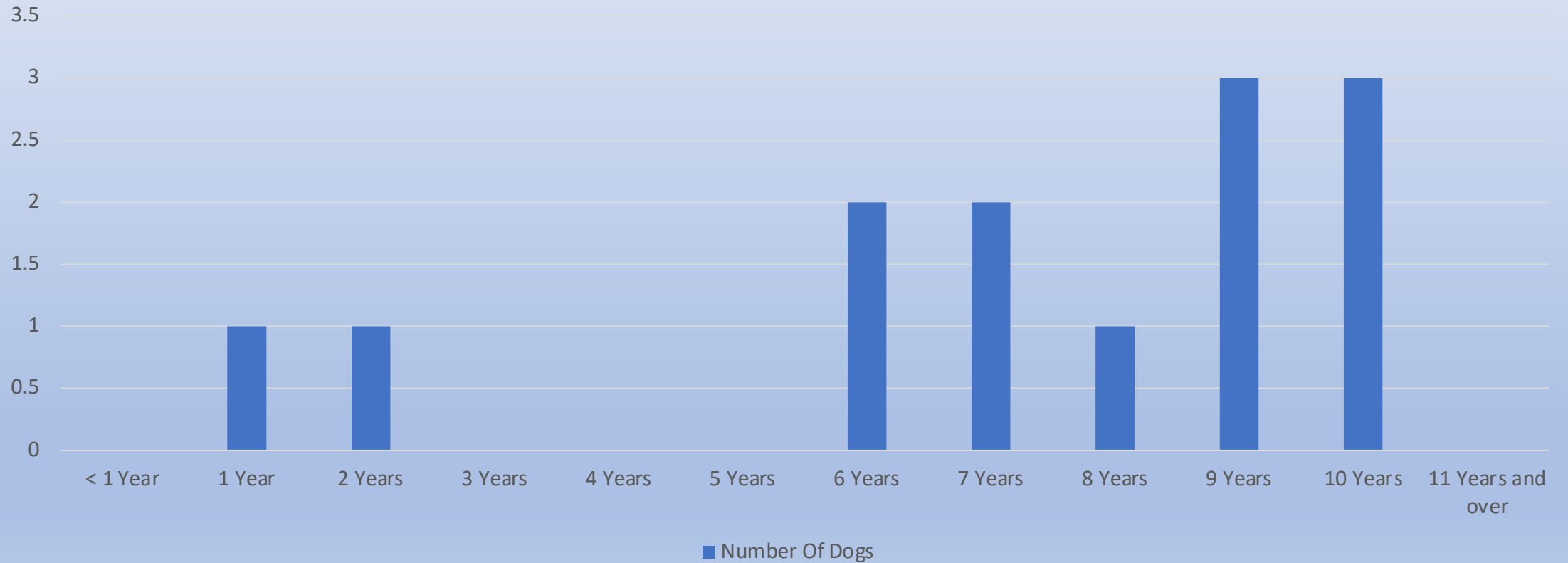

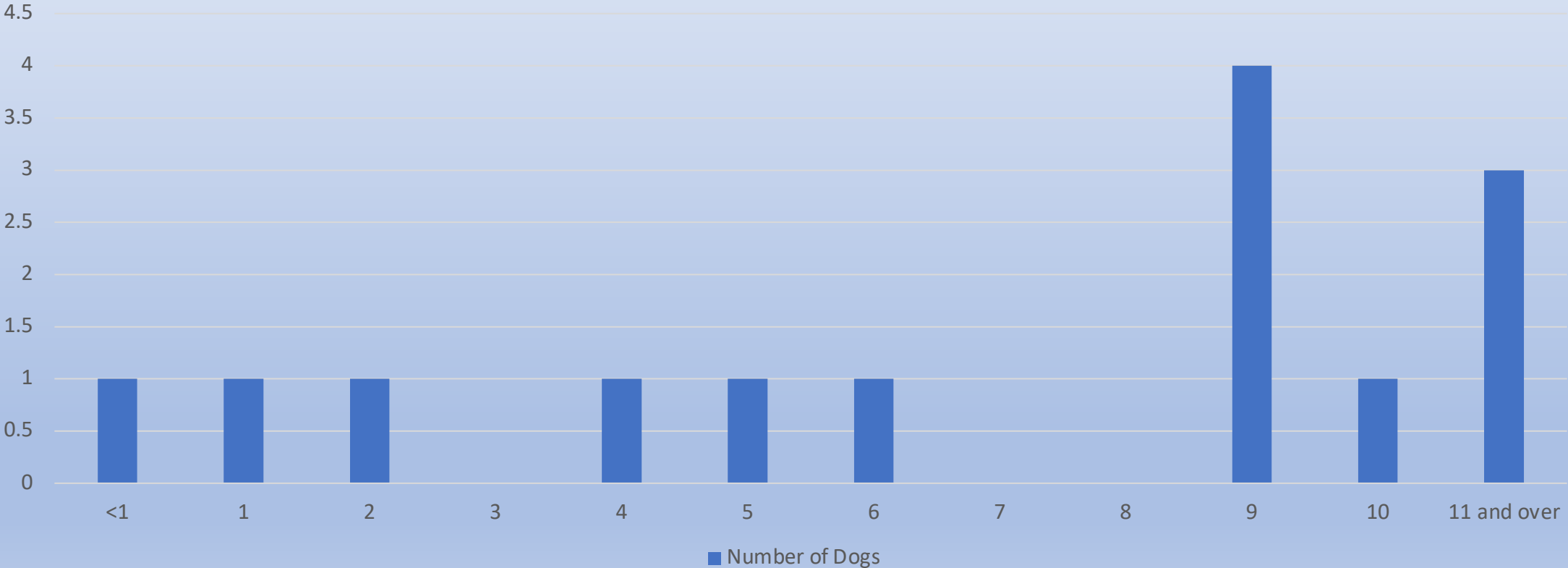

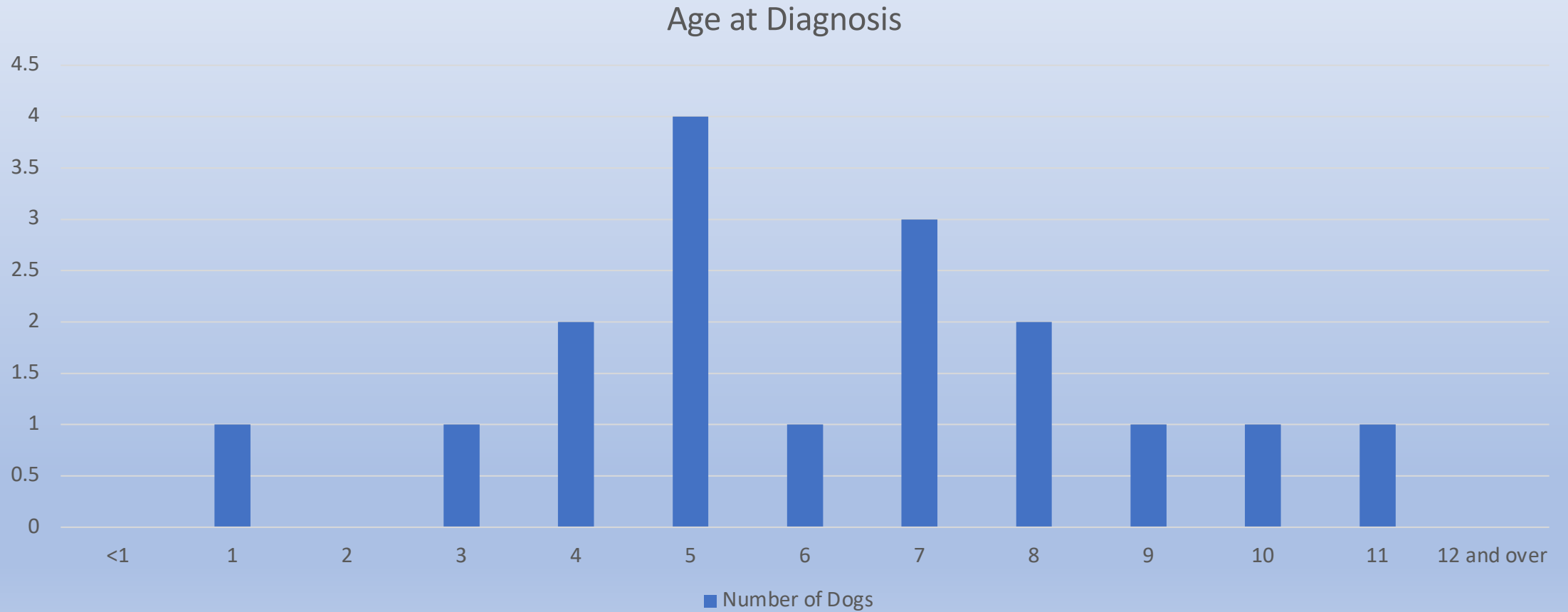

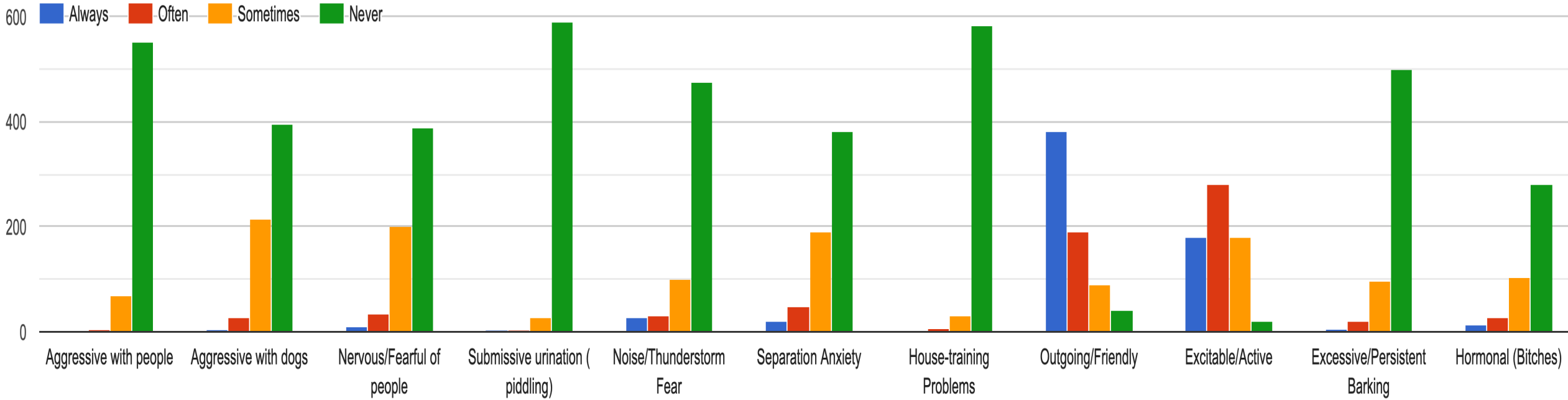

# Notes

- It is important to note that dogs of all ages were included in the survey. Whilst there are exceptions to the rule in most cases the age of the dog had a marked impact on the number of dogs affected.
- Some of the 734 dogs reported more than one condition so will appear more than once in the results.
- The average age of death reported was 9 ½ years.
- The survey indicates that overall Rhodesian Ridgebacks are a healthy Breed.
- Over 45% of dogs never having any reported health issues and many more with only minor non breed specific health issues.
- The biggest areas of concern was Cancers and Tumours with 11.3% of dogs in the survey affected during their lifetime.
