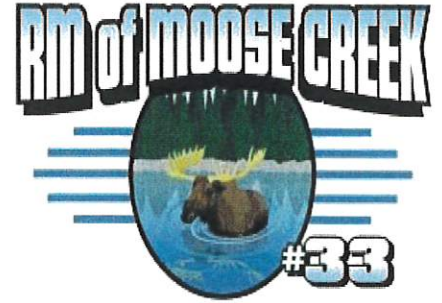

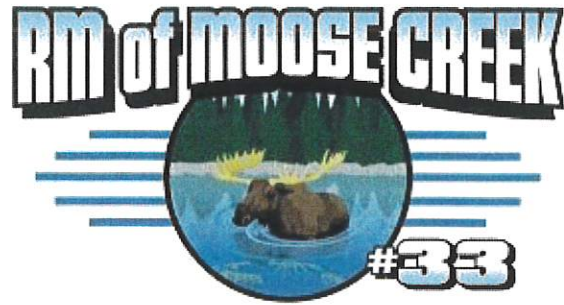

Water Well Tokens: The RM has two wells located within the Municipality boundaries, and one shared well located within the RM of Reciprocity. To access the two wells located at:

1. SW 17-05-03 W2M, and
2. SE 01-06-02 W2M

Water tokens are available for pickup at the office. \$40/year for ratepayers only and \$100/year for commercial usage.

Notary Public and Commissioner of Oaths available to ratepayers at no charge, \$20.00 for non-ratepayers

Gravel for ratepayers at a rate of 16.00/yard is being offered once again at a maximum of 3 loads a year. If you would like to be added to the list please contact the office to fill out a custom work form.

Hay Policy

RM ratepayers that wish to cut and bale ditches shall notify the RM office by June 15th of each year, and furthermore that the cutting, baling and pick up of bales must be completed by July 10th of each year.
