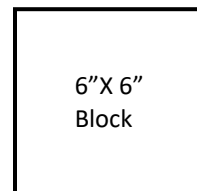
Learn how to cut and then construct the “Wonky Heart” and “Hunter’s Star” block using an AccuQuilt cutter. This is a perfect workshop to take if you bought an AccuQuilt die cutter and have not taken it out of the box!

We will go over the very basics of the AccuQuilt die and cutter, but the emphasis in class will be on constructing the Wonky Heart block and the Hunter’s Star.

No AccuQuilt or dies are needed for the workshop, but if you have the AccuQuilt cutter Wonky Heart die and the Hunter’s Star die **AND THE MAT** just bring it with you to avoid waiting to use the cutters in class. Please bring a mask and hand sanitizer-thanks!

*****Supplies required for Wonky Hearts*****

1. Sewing Machine **AND** BSS (Basic Sewing Supplies-thread pins scissors iron etc)
2. 2 light 11”square pieces of fabric
3. 1 dark contrasting 11” piece of fabric (see examples below)
4. 12 X 12 “piece of scrap cardboard (something stiff to carry your cut patches from the cutter to your work area)
5. A piece of chalk, and a marker or pencil



To finish the 3 heart wall hanging or 3 mug rugs, you will need extra (either the same or coordinating) fabrics for the borders, backing and binding and a scrap piece of batting or felt to complete this project at home.

*****Supplies required for: Hunter’s Star Block*****

1. In addition to the above supplies: 1 yard of light AND 1 yard of dark contrasting fabrics. In class, we will construct a block to learn how to cut and sew it.
