

WRITE A LETTER TO FR. JERRY

When you kneel before the Bishop to be confirmed, you will say,

"Bishop my name is ______, and I wish to be confirmed."

This is a sacred, serious moment and it is important to consider exactly what it means when you say "I wish to be confirmed."

To encourage you to carefully and prayerfully consider <u>what it means to</u> <u>you</u> to be confirmed, you are asked to write a letter addressed to Father Jerry

The letter must include at least the answers to the following questions:

What does it mean to you to be confirmed? Who have you chosen for a sponsor? Why? What name have you chosen for confirmation? Why? What is the significance of your confirmation name? What did this saint do to witness the power of faith and Christian service? What virtue, value, strength, and or characteristic of this saint do you hope to emulate in your own life? How has the confirmation preparation program helped you to come to decide that you want to be confirmed? What have you learned this year? Why do you want to be confirmed?
