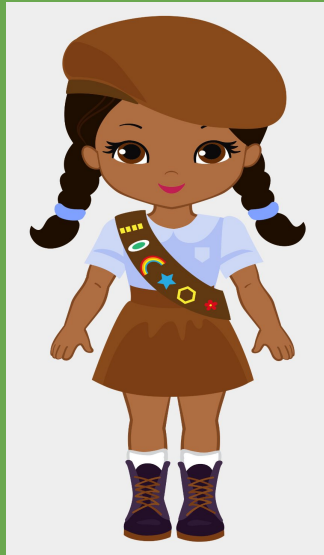

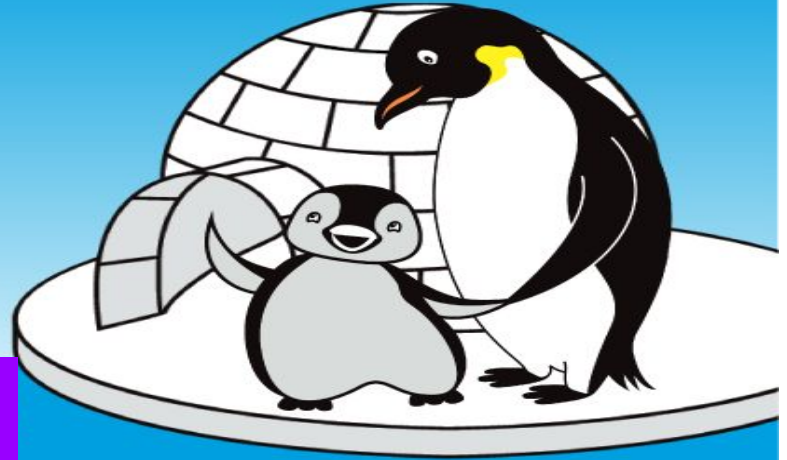

- Submit this form at least 2 weeks in advance of the trip

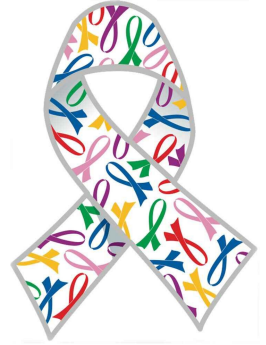
Hosting a Money Making Event

Here are some reminders and new rules...

- Daisies and Brownies may not host money earning events.
- Troops must participate in both Council-sponsored product programs (Fall Products & Cookies)
- Troops may not participate in money earning events during Council-sponsored product programs.
- Troop leaders must submit a completed Money-Earning Application at least three weeks to a Volunteer Support Manager for approval.
- Troops must follow all Safety Activity Checkpoints regarding troop money-earning activities.
- All girls and adults must be registered members of the Girl Scouts of California's Central Coast before participating in any money-earning activity.

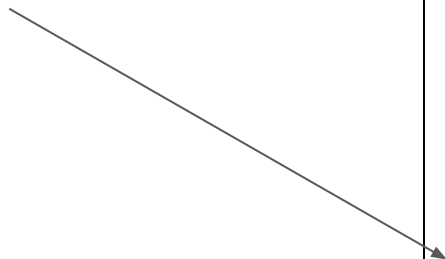
