

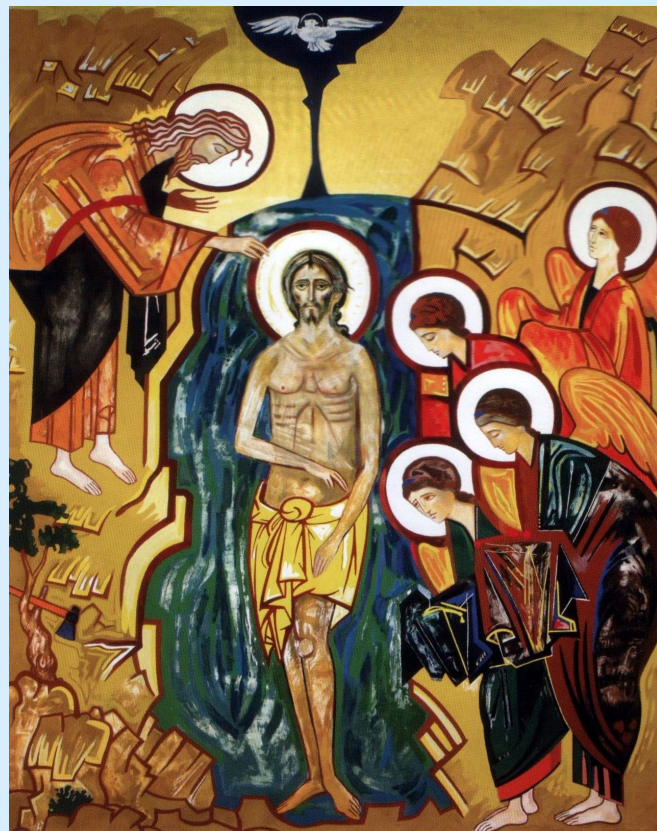

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (Mk 1: 11). These words, recounted by the Evangelist Mark, bring us straight to the heart of today's feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which closes the Christmas season. Today we commemorate the manifestation of the mystery of Trinitarian love, which occurred right at the beginning of the Messiah's public activity. On the holy night in Bethlehem, Jesus was born among us in the poverty of a stable; on the day of Epiphany, the Magi acknowledged him as the long-awaited Messiah of the nations; today, all our attention is focused on his person and mission. The Father speaks to him directly: "You are my beloved Son", as the heavens are opened and the Spirit descends on him in the form of a dove (cf. Mk 1: 10-10). The scene on the banks of the Jordan thus presents the solemn proclamation of Jesus as the Son of God. And so his saving mission begins publicly. The Baptism that the Lord receives takes place in the context of John the Baptist's penitential preaching. The ritual act of being immersed in water, offered by the Precursor, was an outward sign of repentance for sins committed and of the desire for spiritual renewal. All this refers to the Christian sacrament of Baptism, which I will shortly have the joy of administering to these children and which we received a long time ago. Baptism inserted us into God's own life, making us his adopted children in his only-begotten "beloved Son" I invite you to ponder on this reflection of St. John Paul II on the Baptism of the Lord. Remember that we have been called to the dignity of beloved children of God and thus let us ask the grace to live as such.

We have finished the work of Asbestos abatement and now are getting ready to start on the floor. My dear brothers and sisters let us also pray for our country as we start this year. May the events of Wednesday may not be seen again. I invite you to read the declaration of Cardinal Tobin that is on our website. Please pay close attention to the website as we will announce there when we will restart masses in Lennon Hall.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

"Tú eres mi Hijo amado; en ti me complazco" (Mc 1, 11). Estas palabras, narradas por el evangelista Marcos, nos llevan directamente al corazón de la fiesta del Bautismo del Señor de hoy, que cierra el tiempo navideño. Hoy conmemoramos la manifestación del misterio del amor trinitario, que ocurrió justo al comienzo de la actividad pública del Mesías. En la noche santa de Belén, Jesús nació entre nosotros en la pobreza de un establo; en el día de la Epifanía, los Magos lo reconocieron como el Mesías esperado de las naciones; hoy, toda nuestra atención está centrada en su persona y misión. El Padre le habla directamente: "Tú eres mi Hijo amado", mientras los cielos se abren y el Espíritu desciende sobre él en forma de paloma (cf. Mc 1, 10-10). La escena a orillas del Jordán presenta así el solemne anuncio de Jesús como Hijo de Dios. Y así comienza públicamente su misión salvadora. El bautismo que recibe el Señor tiene lugar en el contexto de la predicación penitencial de Juan el Bautista. El acto ritual de sumergirse en agua, ofrecido por el Precursor, era un signo externo de arrepentimiento por los pecados cometidos y del deseo de renovación espiritual. Todo esto se refiere al sacramento cristiano del Bautismo, que en breve tendré la alegría de administrar a estos niños y que recibimos hace mucho tiempo. El bautismo nos insertó en la propia vida de Dios, haciéndonos sus hijos adoptivos en su unigénito "Hijo amado" Los invito a reflexionar sobre esta reflexión de San Juan Pablo II sobre el Bautismo del Señor. Recuerda que hemos sido llamados a la dignidad de hijos amados de Dios y por eso pidamos la gracia de vivir como tales.

"Você é meu Filho amado; contigo me comprazo" (Mc 1,11). Estas palavras, contadas pelo evangelista Marcos, conduzem-nos directamente ao centro da festa de hoje do Baptismo do Senhor, que encerra o tempo do Natal. Hoje comemoramos a manifestação do mistério do amor trinitário, ocorrido logo no início da atividade pública do Messias. Na noite sagrada de Belém, Jesus nasceu entre nós na pobreza de um estábulo; no dia da Epifania, os Magos reconheceram-no como o tão esperado Messias das nações; hoje, toda a nossa atenção está voltada para sua pessoa e missão. O ritual de imersão na água, oferecido pelo Precursor, era um sinal externo de arrependimento pelos pecados cometidos e do desejo de renovação espiritual. Tudo isto se refere ao sacramento cristão do Baptismo, que dentro em breve terei a alegria de administrar a estas crianças e que recebemos há muito tempo. O batismo nos inseriu na própria vida de Deus, tornando-nos seus filhos adotivos em seu unigénito "Filho amado" Convido-vos a refletir sobre esta reflexão de São João Paulo II sobre o Baptismo do Senhor. Lembre-se de que fomos chamados à dignidade de filhos amados de Deus e, por isso, peçamos a graça de viver como tal.
