
Genesis can be broken down into two parts:

- Prehistory contains everything from Genesis 1 to 12, or everything until the birth of Father Abraham. The first part includes creation, the Great Flood and the Tower of Babel.
- From Genesis 12 to 50 is the story of the Patriarchs. They include Abraham, his son Isaac, and Isaac's son Jacob. Jacob was also the father of Joseph, who is not considered a patriarch but is very important.

These men make up the start of the nation of Israel.

GENESIS of

Genesis is not only the first Bible book, but also the longest, covering a period of over 2,000 years. Hence it contains many foundational Bible stories including Creation, the Fall of Man, and those involving Father Abraham and four generations of his founding family. It is also the first book of the Pentateuch, the five first books of the Bible, all written by Moses.
