We will be holding our meeting outside at the arena. We will have a meeting starting at 7 pm. Riders are welcome to bring horses to ride before and after the meeting. Please be aware that there will likely be fireworks nearby (but not on DCTR property). No meal will be served at the meeting.

Saturday July 11th Hillsdale Trail Ride, ride out at 9 am (to beat the heat).

Meet to ride at the day use parking area at the Saddle Ridge Trails. \$5.00 day pass, state park pass or camping fee is required. Bring your friends, family and favorite horses. Non-members welcome!

The Saddle Ridge Trails are rated as moderate easy. Hillsdale has approximately 48 miles of equestrian trails. The trails go through beautiful woods and along the Hillsdale lake.

Directions: Hillsdale Lake is about 1 hour South East of Lawrence Kansas. From Lawrence 59S to 35S to 68E (first exit), stay on 68 E for about 20 + miles, then left on Osawatomie (becomes 271st then Lake Road going over the dam). After you cross the dam turn left on Harmony, then left on W253 (at campground sign and water tower) and right into Saddle Ridge Equestrian Area. For those wanting to extend the ride, DCTR members are camping at the equestrian camp grounds.

To reserve camp sites at Saddle Ridge you will need to call 13-594-3600 as the equestrian sites are reserved by phone. Call or text Rachael Eve at 913 709-1671 or Liz Rombach at 785-393-3107 if you have questions.
