Illness & Exclusion

- Parents / carers must notify the nursery if they are aware that their child has a contagious illness or if a doctor has confirmed they have an illness.
- We will expect parents / carers to cooperate with us by not bringing children to nursery if they have any infectious or contagious illness.
- Children suffering any form of sickness / diarrhoea must not return to the nursery until at least 48 hours have elapsed from the last bout and they are well in themselves.
- Details of incubation periods and exclusion times for illnesses are displayed on the nursery notice board and further information is available from our Nursery Manager / Deputy.
- When a child becomes ill at nursery every effort will be made to contact the parents / carers, who will be requested to collect their child as soon as possible.
- In most cases when a child is sent home due to illness it would be beneficial for them to see a doctor.
- Ofsted must be notified of any serious accident, illness or injury to or the death of any child whilst in our care.
