- ► Every religion had some sort of myth stories about the epic tale of good versus evil.

The Woman - vs 1-2;5-6

1. A great and wondrous sign - refers to the woman, not the dragon.

As great as the dragon is, the woman is greater

2. Sun, moon, and stars

The Woman - vs 1-2;5-6

- ▶Sun symbol of the glory of God
- ► Moon dominion and authority
- ▶Twelve stars royalty and victory.

The Woman - vs 1-2;5-6

- ▶ Twelve stars royalty and victory.
 - ▶NOTE! Babylonian mythology
 - ►The stars are likely the 12 tribes and the 12 apostles - the sign of the universal church
 - ▶Rev 1:20 seven stars are the 7 churches , so here the 12 stars represent the whole people of God

The Woman - vs 1-2;5-6

- 3. Pregnant and about to give birth see v. 5
 - ▶Gives birth to a son
 - ▶One who would rule the nations with an iron scepter See Ps 2:9; Rev 2:27
 - ▶See also Isa 26:17-27:13

The Woman - vs 1-2;5-6

- 4. Fled to the desert place prepared for her for 1,260 days.
 - Satan could not destroy Jesus so he turned his attention to the woman the people of God
 - Desert Place a place of safety and nourishment - See 1 Sam 22:1-2; 1 Kings 19:3-9; Mark 1:12-13

The Woman - vs 1-2;5-6

- 4. Fled to the desert place prepared for her for 1,260 days.
 - ► A place of intimate fellowship with God See Hos 2:14; 1 Kings 17:2-3
 - This is symbolic of God caring for His people during the 3 ½ years of the Great Tribulation.
 - ▶ Spiritual nourishment and refuge
