General Rules for Mini Stockman's Challenge.

Event will be run under Queensland Ag Show Rules.

Age Groups will be – (competitors age determined by their age on the 12th February 2022)

- Junior which will be Under 13 years old
- Juvenile which will be 13 years to under 17 years old
- Associate which will be 17 years and under 21 years old
- Open which will be 21 years and over

There will be prizes awarded to the three (3) competitors with the highest score in each age group in both the Dry Work and the Utility patterns. Fourth competitor will receive acknowledgement in the form of a ribbon only.

In addition, there will be prize money paid to the Aggregate Winner and Aggregate Runner Up of each age group, with the winner receiving a trophy as well.

Limit of ~~two~~ (3) horses per competitor.

Horses can be shared among different age groups, but the same horse can not be ridden by different people in the same age group.

It is permissible for Junior competitors to be on a lead, (the judges will factor this in to their scoring).

Any breed of horse.

Any style of saddle.

Snaffle bit only.

As this event is open to ALL breeds and disciplines, judging will focus on neatness of dress and horse presentation. Neat attire; long sleeve shirt, jeans or jodhpurs, riding boots and an approved standard riding helmet.

PLEASE NOTE PEOPLE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST WEAR AN APPROVED RIDING HELMET.

Competitors will ride the Dry Work Pattern in draw order, then immediately go over and ride the Utility pattern in the same draw order.

The draw will be uploaded on to the Clifton Show Society page on Wednesday the 9th February 2022.

Judges will be Mr Scott Keogh (Dry Work) and Mrs Christine Holmes (Utility), the Judges score will be final.

In the event of scores tying, Score Administrators will go back through each step of the pattern (starting with the last step) until there is a winner.

Patterns are the same as 2021 and can be found in the 2022 Show Schedule.
