We hope 2017 is treating you well and that you have been on some outdoor trips yourself! In 2016, Boston ICO partnered with four Boston-area community organizations to get kids outdoors – exploring and connecting with their natural world. We found our way across eastern Massachusetts and to California (!).

In July 2016, we took three participants and one staff member from our partner agency, Zumix, on a Sierra Club Service Trip to the Trinity Alps of Northern California. Over the course of eight days (and seven nights) in the backcountry the crew joined other volunteers to replace an eroded section of trail leading to East Boulder Lake. Thank you to Sierra Club's National ICO for making the trip possible, and to Allison Rieck, Boston ICO volunteer extraordinaire, for leading the trip!




