The</u> <u>letters of recommendation should address</u>, among other areas, the student's artistic talents. <u>These letters of recommendation will assure us of the student's talent and character.</u>
- <u>The second half of the student application is a student video presentation. The video</u> <u>guidelines and criteria will be sent to student via email, after receiving initial application.</u> *Your help may be needed in the video portion of this application process.*

The application packet should be postmarked no later than Wednesday, March 10, 2021. The video must be completed for viewing by April 5, 2021. <u>We are adhering strictly to these deadline</u>. <u>Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 15, 2021.</u>

- 3) <u>From the teacher of art (or another teacher who can speak to your artistic talent)</u>: a letter which recommends the student for one of the Medina County Art Scholarships.
- 4) Students who advance to an interview will need to submit a video to the scholarship committee; a sample of artwork and questions to be addressed. The guidelines and criteria of video will be sent via email to applicants upon receipt of initial written application.
