Around Town

Now that the Council elections are done and dusted, we congratulate Paul Mercurio as the new Councillor for Watson Ward. We must also pass on our great thanks to Julie Morris for her tireless work over the last few years, not just for Tyabb but also Somerville and Baxter.

We have already been in correspondence with Councillor Mercurio to remind Council of several projects in Tyabb which need urgent attention, the first being the restoration of the Youth (Guide) Hall. A submission has also been sent to Council's 2021/2022 budget asking for the completion of the fence around the Central Reserve. We are hoping the Councillor Mercurio will support this submission. In Facebook postings during the election Councillor Mercurio promised to work on a safe rail crossing opposite Kathleen Crescent, also an upgrade of the path alongside the rail line from Craig Avenue to Mornington Tyabb Road. In addition, work to upgrade Tyabb Central Reserve and Bunguyan Reserve plus a path from Tyabb station to Mornington Tyabb Road.

Most of these projects were covered in the Tyabb Town Plan, but over the past few years have taken a back seat due to the amount of time spent on the Tyabb Airfield Precinct Plan.

We are grateful that Councillor Mercurio will be taking up these important improvements.

We are all aware of the poor condition of many roads around Tyabb. All roads are the responsibility of either the Shire or VicRoads, so to get anything done takes many hours of sustained complaints. If you aware of a road which needs attention, but don't know who is the responsible authority, it would be easier to contact both the Shire and our local state member (Neale Burgess). Another good way to report a problem is to use Snap, Send, Solve. The more complaints the authorities receive the more likely the repairs will be undertaken.

You will have noticed a lot of tree trimming around power lines being undertaken. Households have been informed if work is to be undertaken in their area.

AGM

A reminder that the AGM of the Tyabb & District Ratepayers Group is to be held on **Tuesday**, **8th December at 7:00pm** in the **Somerville Community House**. Unfortunately the CFA rooms in Tyabb are not yet available for use by the community. The Fire Danger Period is when CFA restricts the use of fire in the community. This is to help prevent fires from starting. CFA declares the Fire Danger Period for each Shire or Council at different times in the lead up to the fire season. It depends on the amount of rain, grassland curing rate and other local conditions

To be certain that you are able to burn off check with Council, not forgetting that different rules apply to different sized properties.

The Fire Danger Period for Tyabb is between December and May

· Help With Your Christmas Cooking

When your Christmas cooking and preparation is becoming too much and the hungry hordes are rapidly approaching here's something you can try.

Classic Christmas Cake




Ingredients:

- I cup butter
- I cup sugar
- 6 drops lemon juice
- Some nuts
- 4 large eggs
- Itspn baking powder
- 4 cups dried mixed fruits
- I or 2 bottles of whisky

Method:

Sample whisky to check quality. Select a large mixing bowl. Check the whisky again as it must be just right. To ensure that the whisky is of top quality, pour I large glass and drink fast. Meanwhile, check the whisky is still top quality by crying another tup. Repeat. Add 2 large eggs, 2 cups dried fruit and beat till high. If the fruit gets stuck in the beaters, push it through with a drewscriber ... sample the whisky again, checking the consistency. Next, sift 3 cups salt, or something, it really doesn't matter. Whample the whisky. Sift half a pint of lemon juice. Fold I tablespoon brown sugar, or whatever colour you find and mix well. Drink the remaining whisky. Grease the oven and turn cake into pan at 200 degrees. Pour everything into the oven and go to bed.
