Step 3 Guidance for Communal Worship during the COVID 19 Pandemic

Although the vaccine rollout programme is very successful, it is recommended that the key measures, which churches and parishes have been carrying out, remain in place for now:

- 1)<u>Hand sanitiser must continue to be used on entry to churches & before liturgies</u> as in current church guidance, reduces risk. Please either scan in on the NHS Track & Trace or tick your name off the register.
- 2) <u>The wearing of face coverings</u>, even if removed by law, remains at least for now (apart from those who are exempt.). Please ensure that face coverings are worn properly, covering the nose, to reduce aerosol or droplet spread.
- 3) <u>Social Distancing continues.</u> People sit 1m apart in the church pews.

<u>Offertory collection at Mass</u> There are baskets at the entrance and exit from the church. Where possible, please use the contactless donation system. Payments can be made from a Stand in the church porch. <u>Physical exchange of a Sign of Peace</u> remains suspended.

<u>Holy Communion</u> is given in the hand only. Please wait in your pew until instructed to move forward. The communicant should have his/her arms outstretched to the full, palms facing upwards, one on top of the other. After unlooping the face covering the communicant consumes the Sacred Host at the sanctuary steps, replaces the face covering and moves back to the pew via one of the side aisles.

Remember HANDS - FACE - SPACE
