SANDWICHES IN THE PARK

Our dedicated volunteers provide soup, sandwiches and hot chocolate to people in Boitanio Park each Sunday at Noon. The sandwiches and hot chocolate are made in the church basement after Sunday morning Mass by a group of volunteers and various members take turns making homemade soup to be delivered to the park. On average we serve about 50 people, or as we like to call them 'Friends', each Sunday.

FOOD BAGS

On these days, we also provide coffee, juice and snacks and take this opportunity to visit with our 'Friends' to get to know them better.
