## A Church Paul Would Recognize: We belong to...



In a typical year, St. Mark's would have celebrated the beginning of the school year and the church programming year with Rally Day. In a typical year, I would have handed out Stewardship packets in the library. In a typical year, Rev. Sarah would have outlined the plans for Christian Formation for the year.

This is not our typical year. This is not how any of us envisioned 2020. Our church is going through both a major building project and a transition in spiritual leadership; either one of those alone could overwhelm a congregation. This is not to mention the global pandemic that is preventing our members from gathering together to lift ourselves in communal worship and prayer. Our vestry and church leadership team have done yeoman's work to keep the congregation connected through internet and email. It has not been an easy task and we all owe them our gratitude.

Conducting a stewardship campaign during 2020 is a daunting endeavor. With so much uncertainty before us, pledging funds for the next year takes a leap of faith. Or does it? This year, the Stewardship campaign is challenging St. Mark's to remain a church Paul would recognize. Paul wrote letters to the churches he knew, extoling their virtues and admonishing their errors, yet always teaching them. His key lessons centered on faith in Christ's message and support of fellow believers. Our church on the hill has been a place of faith and fellowship since 1884. The faith and fellowship of St. Mark's has sustained our church family across centuries and that faith and fellowship will sustain our church family in the future.

#### Paul wrote to the Corinthians.

What I mean is this: that each one of you says, "I belong to Paul," "I belong to Apollos," "I belong to Cephas," "I belong to Christ." Has Christ been divided? Was Paul crucified for you, or were you baptized in Paul's name? It is because of God that you are in Christ Jesus.

1st Corinthians 1:11-12

When someone says, "I belong to Paul," and someone else says, "I belong to Apollos," aren't you acting like people without the Spirit? After all, what is Apollos? What is Paul? They are servants who helped you to believe. Each one had a role given to them by the Lord. - 1st Corinthians 3:4-9

Paul's letters reminded early congregations that it was not institutional leadership that made the church a home or made a congregation a body; it is the faith and fellowship of the church members that creates the church. This message is just as important today. We have been blessed with amazing spiritual leaders who taught, nurtured us, and helped guide our congregation, but that leadership is not St. Mark's identity. As those wonderful leaders said, we know who we are *and* who's we are: We belong to God. St. Mark's will continue to gather together and grow for the glory of God because of the faith and fellowship our beloved members.

Paul sent letters to early Christians who were feeling isolated in troubling times, encouraging them to care for one another and have trust in God's grace. He called for fearless discipleship during those trials, and expected that discipleship to spill over into all areas of believers' lives. His letters asked that people be inclusive, joyful and quick to forgive. Lastly, Paul charged the early church members to recognizes those gifts they have received from God and to share selflessly.

St. Mark's is a church that Paul would recognize and will remain a church Paul would recognize. I ask you all to keep our faith and fellowship in your hearts while you discern your pledge offering for the coming year.

Until we can gather again for formation the Youth and Children are invited to create outings.


The youth have already met outside at member's houses. Other opportunities are being created and discussed among the youth. If you have and idea that you would like to organize please let us know so we can help you communicate.


While this is a parish wide gathering we would love to see as many youth past and present and we take an opportunity to wish Matt well on his new journey.
