## JYD President's Report

Portage Junk Yard Dogs Inc. had another successful year because of the support from members and volunteers. JYD took in \$10,700 in membership fees in 2022, which supports out ambitious program of cycling, hiking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. JYD is a unique amongst recreations clubs in Manitoba. We are the largest recreation club and the most self-sufficient financially of any other club in the Province. This is something to be proud of. In addition to JYD's regular activities, the Club is partnering with the City of Portage la Prairie to construct an Activity Park, which will include a bike park, accessible hiking trails and upgraded toboggan run. Due to our financial position, JYD was able to put \$10,000 into the project as seed money.

As of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022, JYD had 384 members, which is double pre-pandemic numbers, but down from a high of near 600 during the pandemic. Below is a breakdown of membership. Ninety-three percent of members are from Portage and District. Family memberships represent 81% of total members.
