

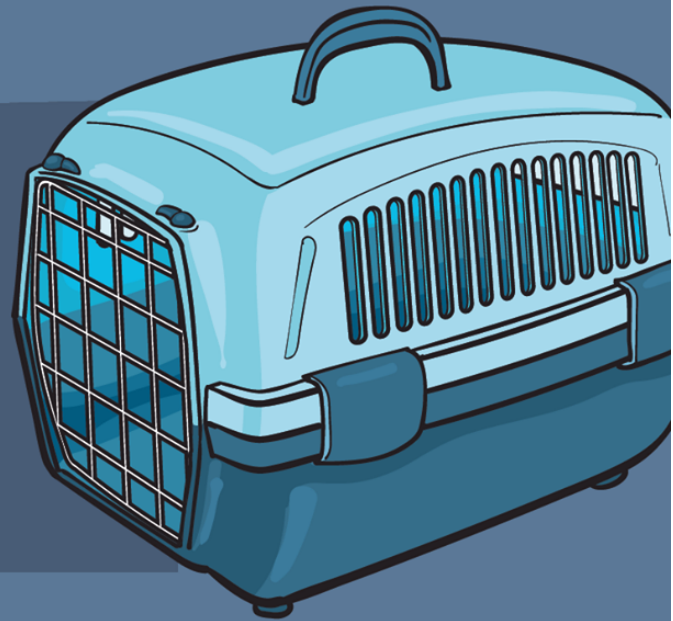
Travelling...

WITH YOUR DOG

Under Rule 57 of The Highway Code, it is your responsibility for making sure that your dog is suitably restrained whilst travelling in a vehicle.

Recommended appropriate ways to safely restrain your dog whilst travelling in a vehicle are...

-  **SEAT BELT HARNESS**
-  **PET CARRIER**
-  **DOG CAGE**
-  **DOG GUARD**



If found that you are not travelling with your dog safely restrained, you could face a fine of up to £5,000 and will invalidate your car insurance.
