## Go Fish

2-5 Players

## Starting the Game

Pass out 5 Israel tribe cards to each person. Then place the rest of the cards face down in the middle. This is known as the Go Fish pile.

Note: Remove the 12 Tribes of Israel Card before passing out the cards.

## Taking a Turn

Each player takes a turn going clockwise around the circle (to the person's left).
During a turn the player asks another player if have a particular tribe card. For example, the player asks John if he has any Judahs. If John has any Judahs, then he must give all of his Judahs to the player. If John doesn't have any Judah's, then he answers "go fish".

When you "go fish" you take a card from the Go Fish Pile in the middle.
If the player gets all four cards of the same tribe, then they place the cards face up in front of them. If player runs out of all cards in his hand, he then selects five more cards of the pile.

If there are no more cards left in the pile, then the players turn is done and it moves onto the next person.

## Finishing the Game

The game is over when all cards have been matched and nobody has any cards left in their hand.
There are no winners or losers of the game, so enjoy!

## Alternative Play

Instead of matching four cards, you can match two instead.
For 2-3 players, start with 7 cards.

## The 12 Tribes of Israel

2-5 Players

## Starting the Game

Pass out all Israel tribe cards to each person until there are none left. If some players have more cards than others, it's ok.

## Taking a Turn

Each player takes a turn going clockwise around the circle (to the person's left).
During a turn the player takes one card from a player that he chooses.
If the player matches a card that he already has, he put the pair down. If the card doesn't match, then the player keeps it.

Repeat until no more cards are left and the only card left is the 12 Tribes of Israel Card.

## Finishing the Game

The game is finished once the only card left is the 12 Tribes of Israel.
There are no winners or losers of the game, so enjoy!
