- 2). A biographical summary/resume to include school performance, school accomplishments and involvements along with any community, civic, church or other activities.
- 3). A clear statement of your academic objective and the school you plan to attend.
- 4). A clear statement of financial needs (to include your efforts to achieve the financial need).
- 5). Since we are an organization recognizing and honoring veterans, we are requiring a brief story about your relative who is a member of the KVHOF.
- 6). We request you attend our annual induction ceremony to personally receive your scholarship check. If you cannot attend, we request a short video about you that could be presented during the ceremony.

7). To ensure readability of your information; application must be either typed or computer generated.
