- Submit a 250-500 page essay and describe how your degree will apply to nursing
- A current professional photo (headshot) place picture in a separate email file
- Must be enrolled in an Accredited School of Nursing
- Must have <u>at least 1 full year remaining</u> in school
- Must show evidence of active participation in local chapter and evidence of community service.
- Two letters of recommendation (one from applicant's school of nursing or employer and one from a nurse in the area, politician, or religious leader).

- Contact your school for an official transcript, and have them mail your transcript DIRECTLY to SCBNA before the deadline date of <u>October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021</u>
