Spring Valley Nature Club Heirloom Plant Sale

We will have an heirloom plant sale but with new rules. The sale will be all <u>pre-orders</u> with a no contact curbside pick-up May 31st 10:00 AM thru 1:00 PM at Spring Valley. Stay in your car, we will bring your order of plants and load them in the car for you.

We can also provide <u>free</u> delivery for orders over \$25 within 4 miles of Spring Valley. Orders of \$25 or more 5-9 miles from Spring Valley add \$15. Orders of \$25 or more10-15 miles from Spring Valley add \$25. <u>Sorry</u>, no deliveries greater than 15 miles from Spring Valley. Spring Valley Update for May/June

Like every other aspect of our society, Spring Valley has and will be changed by the COVID-19 pandemic. I've provided some important updates below, but of course, the situation has continued to change over time, sometimes quickly, so for more up-to-date information, please visit the Schaumburg Park District website at www.parkfun.com. You may also call the Nature Center at (847) 985-2100; however, staff is not always there to answer the phones and it may take a day or two before we reply to messages left on voicemail.

- In accordance with State of Illinois mandates and recommendations of public health officials, Spring Valley's facilities and all other Park District facilities remain closed until further notice. This includes the Nature Center, Heritage Farm, and Bison's Bluff Nature Playground.
- Spring Valley's grounds and trails will remain open for walkers and no restrooms or portable toilets are available at the site, at least for the time being.
- All scheduled programs and events through May have been cancelled, including the Pollinator Picnic and the
 Native Plant & Heirloom Vegetable Sale. Additionally, since it is expected that advisories against group
 gatherings will remain in place until further notice, all events through July have been cancelled. This includes the
 Country Fair, Buzzin' About Insects, our first two German Beer Gardens, and our just scheduled Summer
 Concert at the Cabin.
- Summer camps and other programs will be redesigned, if possible, to comply with greatly reduced group maximums and social distancing guidelines.
- With restrictions on group gatherings, all scheduled meetings and rentals are also cancelled until further notice.
- Schaumburg Park District will be following re-opening guidelines established by the Centers for Disease Control and the State of Illinois, as we move into summer and gradually reopen facilities and begin to offer programs.

Just as we have already and will continue to see great disruption to our national, state and local economies, even as we all begin to re-engage socially, Spring Valley's operations and programs will change significantly during the coming months. My hope is that many of these changes will turn out to be temporary, and that out of this whole experience, we will all discover positive new ways of engaging with each other as well as our patrons along with many of the tried-and-true ways we already know. Indeed, remaining positive and optimistic in the face of these disruptions and challenges will be key to us getting through them.

Be safe and well, everyone, and take comfort in walks at Spring Valley whenever you can!
