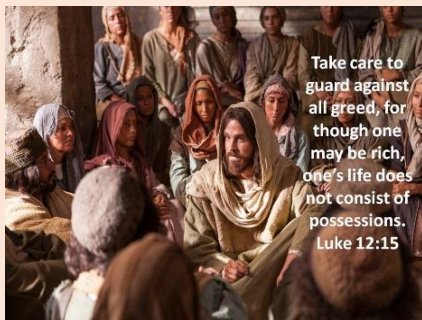

Holy Land Pilgrimage for 2023

The Vernon Villages of the Mission Immaculata (MI) are coordinating a Holy Land Pilgrimage in conjunction with parishes in Vancouver. Security, travel, accommodation and meals will be "all inclusive" in Vatican affiliated hotels. The guided pilgrimage, September 4 through September 14, 2023 will include the sites where Jesus Christ was born, raised, baptized, suffered his passion and was resurrected (itinerary attached). All-inclusive costs, are estimated at \$6000.00 CAD per individual. Air travel will be Vancouver to Tel Aviv and return. Bus transportation will be available from Vernon to Kelowna and return.
