
### 2022 Dressage Camp

- We are planning on submitting a proposal to VADA State Board to get some assistance for funding




### Isabel F. deSzinay Memorial Dressage Show

The Isabel F. deSzinay Memorial Dressage Show held in memory of Bettina Longaker's mother and organized by the Charlottesville chapter was wet, cold, and windy but a successful show! Seventy-nine horses were entered and 189 tests were scheduled over the weekend at our Level 2 show. Due to the adverse weather conditions, scratches were evident but not abundant. Riders rode through the worst of it all weekend only to have the sun pop at the end of the show day on Sunday.

Classes included Opportunity, FEI Musical Freestyle rides, Dressage Seat Equitation and Training Level tests up through Grand Prix level. Our own Chapter President, Meylni Worth, competed her colorful Knabstrupper "Tinuvel" at the Intermediate Level.

We had wonderfully loyal members of our chapter volunteer their time to assist in running a smooth show. THANK YOU TO EVERY VOLUNTEER THAT JOINED THE MANAGEMENT TEAM IN PUTTING THIS SHOW ON! WE TRULY APPRECIATE YOU! Volunteers are an important part of the show. We can't do it without them (you!). Volunteers also get credit or 'hours" towards high score awards at the end of the year – both schooling USEF/USDF licensed show high score awards. Volunteers may qualify or eligible for the two \$500 scholarship lottery held each year in September. The scholarship money may be used for any dressage-related experience a volunteer may have.
