

COP 26 CLIMATE TALKS Pope Francis and dozens of religious leaders have signed a joint appeal to governments to commit to ambitious targets at the upcoming UN climate conference in Glasgow. The religious leaders also promised to do their own part to lead their faithful towards more sustainable behaviour, as "care for the environment is a moral imperative to preserve God's creation for future generations". "We have inherited a garden; we must not leave a desert to our children," said the appeal, which was signed at a formal ceremony in the Apostolic Palace before being handed over to the COP26 President, Alok Sharma.



The "Faith and Science: towards COP26" meeting brought together Christian leaders including the Archbishop of Canterbury, the Orthodox Ecumenical Patriarch, as well as representatives of Islam, Judaism, Hinduism, Sikhism, Buddhism, Confucianism, Taoism, Zoroastrianism, and Jainism.

"Allow me to offer three concepts for reflection on this shared endeavour: Openness to interdependence and sharing, the driving force of love and the call to respect," declared Pope Francis. In their appeal, the church leaders begged political leaders to adopt measures to limit temperature rise and for countries that are most responsible for greenhouse gas emissions to provide financial support to the most vulnerable communities.

#### SYNOD OF BISHOPS 2023

Following the recent Pastoral Letter, materials to assist in the diocesan contribution to the Synodal Journey will soon be available. Bishop Richard asks parishes, where possible, to arrange Advent Groups to discuss the questions that have been asked of us. There will also be a facility for on-line contributions. Responses will need to be returned to me by 6th January 2022. This will give time for them to be drawn together and written up in preparation for a webinar for the diocese on 16th February. Our diocesan contribution will then be sent to the Bishops' Conference as part of the national contribution to the work of the Synod.

The Synod is an important event in the life of the Universal Church and we are asked to keep this work in prayer, both personally and in the intercessions at Mass.

- 1. <u>Opening of Churches</u> Church Buildings can be left open unsupervised for individual prayer at times when there are no public acts of worship. OLOL Church will be sanitized when it is locked each day.
- 2. <u>Freeing the Benches</u> Ribbons have been taken off the <u>left hand</u> side of the church as this is the side where we do not have to socially distance. <u>KNEELERS</u> are <u>NOT</u> to be used <u>EXCEPT</u> on the <u>right hand</u> side of the church which will remain socially distanced and taped off, for those who feel the need to shield a bit more.
- 3. 'Leave a Space Cards' are available to pick up from the porch table and at the back of the church so that people who wish to maintain a space between themselves and the next person can put a card beside them on the bench.
- 4. <u>Track and Trace</u> We shall follow our track and trace routines for as long as the NHS system is in operation. We shall keep the track and trace mass sheets, as well as the OR system. **This is mandatory**.
- 5. <u>One Way Systems</u> One way systems are no longer mandatory, but we will continue opening the old main entrance back door, so that people may be allowed to choose by which route they wish to exit from the church.
- 6. **Stewards** will sanitise the church at the end of mass. We shall therefore continue with two stewards.
- 7. **Holy Communion** No change please wait for the steward to guide you.
- 8. **Congregational singing inside** to be reviewed.
- 9. <u>The Offertory Collection</u> For the time being we will continue to ask the congregation to continue to use the baskets (and Dona Contactless facility at OLOL) at the entrance and exits from the churches.
