Upcoming Visit – Owl and Birds of Prey Sanctuary

We are pleased to inform you that as we continue to enhance our enrichment activities, we have secured visits to the Turbary Woods Rescue and Rehabilitation Center, Preston on Friday 11 June for the main cabin and Tuesday 15 June 2021 for the nurture cabin.

This facility offers a unique collection of over 90 birds of prey including eagles, hawks, falcons, owls, vultures and more unusual species.

All the birds are housed in large open fronted aviaries, sheltered in a woodland setting. We will be experiencing first hand the breathtaking flight of a falcon. Hawks, owls, and other varieties are also flown at the sanctuary and students will gain hands on experience and knowledge about these fascinating birds.

In the hope that the weather might be kind, it is recommended that your son has sun screen, sunglasses and a sun cap with him. Obviously, there is no guarantee about the weather and indeed waterproofs might instead be the order of the day!

As always, school will provide lunch, snacks and water.

During both visits, we will be travelling in the school cars. Staff and pupils will be required to wear a face mask in the car and sanitise their hands both upon arrival and on leaving the centre.
