# **Contributions Requested**

Your help is needed to keep our Supreme Temple in Oklahoma ready for future generations of Rainbow Girls. There is an ongoing Century Campaign to restore and renew the building in McAlester, Oklahoma. The Century Campaign is divided into three parts - Heating/AC replacement, Exterior repair of the building, and last to establish an Endowment Fund for future needs. Phase 1 -The Heating/A replacement has been completed. Phase 2 - fixing the exterior of the building is our current goal of which \$388,000 is needed to complete the repairs. During Supreme Assembly in Oklahoma City this past summer, the Masonic Charity Foundation of Oklahoma gifted the Century Campaign with \$100,000. They also issued a challenge to all other jurisdictions - They will match all contributions up to another \$100,000 through the end of the year. CT Rainbow will also match all contributions to this fund, up to \$1,000, donated before November 30th, 2022. So your donation can be tripled! We will also be collecting at our visitations in September and November.
