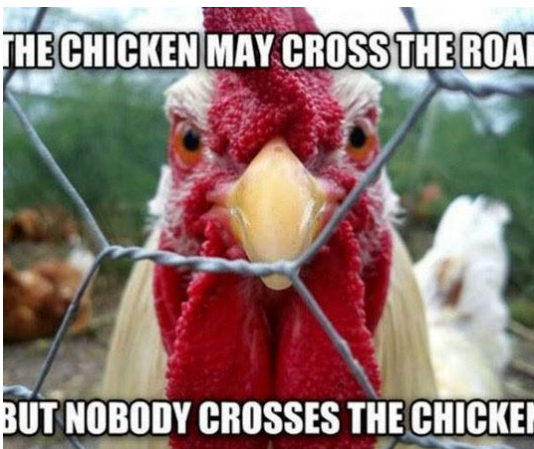
This weeks items:

What is Cilantro?

This spice is commonly used while cooking fish or making homemade salsa. It has a unique flavor and is somewhat similar to fresh parsley.

.Very thankful to have some natural rain this week. Although we keep up with irrigation as needed, natural rain is much better and makes things grow so much better. Frost patrol found that a lot of the green beans needed to be replanted, as did some of the round zucchinis otherwise we fared very well compared to others.
