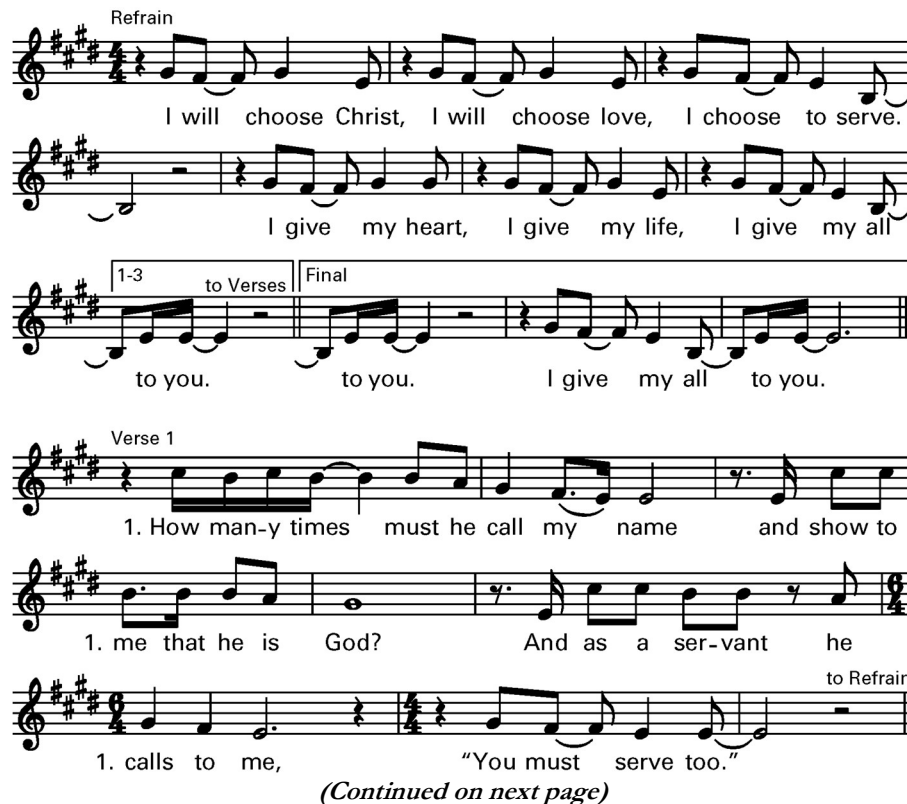
A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MARK 8:27-35

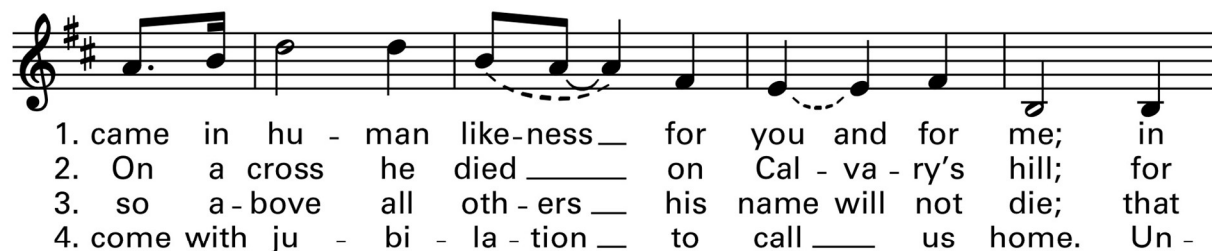
