TREASURER'S REPORT

From August 24th to September 24th, 2013, we had a net income of \$3,292.09, coming from EZ money and membership. During that time, we had \$4,018.18 in expenses paid out, for communication copies and classroom enrichment.

INCOME: Easy money from Target totaled \$591.76. The clearance spirit wear brought in \$274.00. Our Flyer Night brought us \$168.00, and eScrip brought us \$202.38. Last, flat donations has already brought us \$173.00 this year. With membership, we have deposited 250 membership payments of \$1,250, but still have some pending. Of this, \$1,012.50 will be remitted to our parent PTA association, Third District, in October.

EXPENSES: Expenses for Boxtops was \$56.70 for shipping. We have funded \$1,774.50 in classroom enrichment so far as well. We spent \$128 towards our PLC events. Bingo night expenses were \$287.41 and Book exchange materials cost \$51.37. For our PTA Info Night, \$432.96 was spent on supplies and copies. Communications and copies were our largest expense this month at \$1,284.44 to get our membership and all of our Back to School information.
