5. Counseling/Principal Corner: The counselors are meeting with senior students. They hope to encourage every senior to apply to at least one college during college week. Counselor have seen more students having difficulty adjusting emotionally to this school year. The district plans to use COVID funding to hire an additional counselor to work part time in assisting with the workload in the counseling office. Counselors have also adjusted their hours to include being available from 4pm-7pm on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of each month.

Mr. Wihongi shared that the vote for the graduation venue resulted in over 64% choosing Zions Bank Stadium. It will be held at that location on Jun 2, 2022.

Principal Wihongi talked about the new default grading scale approved by the School Leadership Team and teachers. The new scale, patterned after those at other high schools in the area, seeks to address issues with the previous grading scale based on educational research. The new scale is a default grading scale, but departments can adjust the scale based on proficiency levels as they determine appropriate for that PLC. This evolved from the "Grading By Design" professional development held for the district in August.
