

Thank you for allowing us the opportunity to care for your child. We are so excited to meet you and your family. We hope to make your child's learning experience fun and exciting while installing a love of learning that will last throughout your child's lifetime.

What You Can Expect

Our classroom uses Funshine Express curriculum for Toddlers to plan our monthly activity calendars. Our activities focus on the following learning standards: Social/ Emotional, Math/Science, Creative Expression, Language & Emerging Literacy and Physical Health and Development. All activities correlate with our state GELDS (Georgia Early Learning & Development Skills) We utilize a "rolling schedule" based on our student's needs and temperaments when planning our daily activities. Research shows that children learn better and more thoroughly through play. Keeping this in mind, the majority of our activities are "hands on". Many times when you view your child in their classroom setting, it may seem that we are just playing when in reality our students are learning through teacher guided and student choice play. We strive to teach our toddlers the skills necessary to become self-reliant. We begin teaching them to eat using proper utensils and move to drinking from a cup with no lid. We also encourage our students to help serve themselves at mealtimes and solve minor conflicts throughout the day. We also start to instill good safety and hygiene by teaching proper hand washing and the correct way to use play equipment.

You will be given a bi-month newsletter the first week of every other month. You can also view activity calendars in our Classroom Information Area located on the wall in the classroom. Your child will also be signed up for Preschool Gazette. This is an online version of our daily "tattler sheets". In this program we will log some of your child's activities for the day, how they ate and napped, and what their mood was. We will also use Preschool Gazette to leave you notes about your child and the center. This information will be made available to you through your email and will be updated periodically throughout the day.

What We Need From You

Our center provides everything that your child should need throughout the day. However, there are a few things that we need from you.

- Please make sure that your child always has weather appropriate change of clothing at all times. If your child has an accident and doesn't have a change of clothing, the office will have to contact you to bring some. We really don't want to bother you during the day.
- It is very important that we have diapers and wipes for your child at all times. When our supply is getting low, we will let you know via Preschool Gazette. If you would also like us to send you a text message reminding you, please let us know and we will do so. If you do not supply these items when needed and your child runs out, you will be charged \$2 for every center diaper that is used until you furnish the supplies needed.
- In each of our classrooms, we post a family board of our students. Please bring any pictures that you wish to share of your child with members of your family. These photos will never be published or displayed anywhere but our classroom. We have found that they bring comfort to some children to "see" their family during the day.

Important Policy Reminders & Classroom Info

This is a list of some important center reminders. You can find more comprehensive information in your Parent Handbook.

- ❖ All fees are due the Monday of the week of service by 6:00pm. If not paid by that time, a \$40 late fee will be added to your account and must be paid before your child is allowed to return to school.
- ❖ If your child becomes sick during the day with a fever of 101 degrees or higher, or another potentially contagious symptom, you will be notified and expected to pick your child up within one hour. Depending on your child's ailment, you may not be able to bring your child back to daycare for at least 24 hours AFTER symptoms end.
- ❖ Breakfast ends promptly at 8:30am. If you would like for your child to eat breakfast at the center, please have them here no later than 8:20am.
- Please do not bring any toys, food (unless medically necessary), cups, or utensils for your child to the center. We provide everything that your child will need throughout the day.
- Please do not bring a pacifier nor bottle for your child. Our staff teaches our students how to self sooth without having to rely on a pacifier or bottle.
- ❖ Please make sure that your child has a weather appropriate pair of shoes on every day; preferably hard soled walking shoes or tennis shoes. We are required to go outside everyday weather permitting. We do not have extra staff available to stay inside with your child should they not be able to go outside. Additionally, if your child is too sick to go outside, please keep them at home.
- ❖ You must clock your child in/out every day on the attendance computer located by the front desk. Your child also must be accompanied by an adult to and from their classroom. If you fail to clock your child in or out, you will be charged \$2 per occurrence.
- ❖ If you did not do so when enrolling your child, an up to date immunization certificate must be provided to the office within 30 days of enrolling and must be kept up to date throughout your child's stay at our center.
- ❖ If you would like to make a suggestion of comment about our center, there is a suggestion box located in the resource room downstairs. All suggestions/comments are kept confidential.

Thank you for allowing us the pleasure of caring for your child. We have an open door policy and parents are welcome to visit anytime their child is here.
