I would like to thank all of you for your prayers and generosity in helping to fulfill the Annual Diocesan Appeal goals of our cluster parishes.

Thank you, all Lay Directors, Carol Kirkpatrick and Marty Boeckenstedt of St. Joseph in Hills, Carol Lively and Marge Comer of St. Mary in Lone Tree and Cindy Massey and Adam Gauger of St. Mary in Nichols, for attending the Annual Corporate Board meeting on Tuesday, October 19. Lay directors fulfill a civil role as members of the parish corporate board. Lay directors are appointed for a two-year term by the Bishop, upon nomination



by the pastor. This appointment may be automatically renewed up to three times for up to a total of eight consecutive years of service. Parish by-laws specifically require two lay directors. They serve in a position of trust in both a fiduciary and custodial role with the duty to care for the temporal goods of the parish, ensuring that those goods are used wisely in the best interests of the parish. The duty of care requires lay directors to discharge their duties in good faith with the degree of diligence, care and skill that any prudent person would exercise under similar circumstances. The duty of loyalty requires the lay director to act in a manner that does not harm the parish corporation.

Also, thank you to those who attended a short retreat that took place on Thursday, October 21st at St. Joseph Parish Hall with Sr. Agnes Giblin from St. Mary Parish in Iowa City. It was a nice retreat.

There will be a "Rite of Consecration to St. Joseph" that will take place at the All Saints Mass on Monday, November 1st at 6:30pm at St. Joseph Church.

When you come to the Cluster All Souls Mass at 6:30pm on Tuesday, November 2nd at Hills, you are invited to bring your loved ones' pictures who have gone before us in faith, so that you can light a candle to pray for them.
