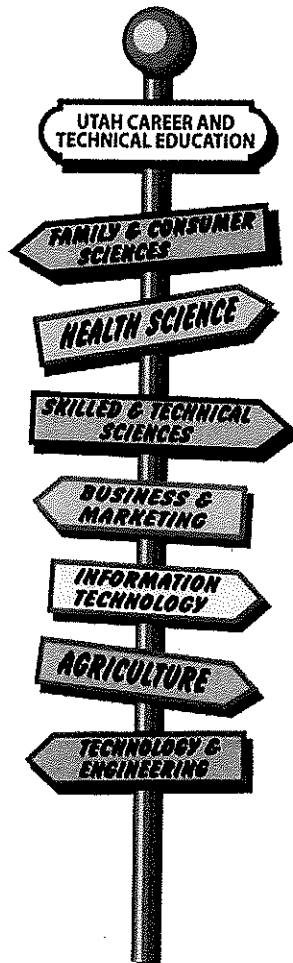

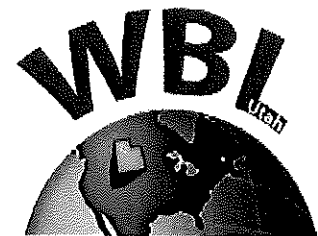
CTE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM
