



Rules:

- 1) Grade 4 riders must show one handed.
- 2) All grades may hold the saddle horn or any other equipment for safety.
- 3) Helmets for WPR classes are optional. WPR endorses and encourages the use of a helmet, but this will be left to the discretion of the rider.
- 4) WPR Approved events with over \$2000.00 in prizes or prize money must consider the following grading options for riders:
 - A) A Rider is FEI classified and that classification and grade will be used by WPR
 - B) Riders who are not FEI classified will be required to submit a WPR Physician Statement.
- 5) Riders have the choice to grade themselves for the 2016 competition year. If they are FEI classified, they must adhere to the grade that they are classified in, or are allowed to ride in the grade above. If a rider is not FEI classified they can choose their grade, but WPR will provide a grading outline and has the right to place a rider in an appropriate grade if deemed necessary.
- 6) WPR has the right to defer to the organizing show association Rules and Regulations at any time.
