Senate Bill 001 – Require Private Armed Organizations to Register with DOJ Introduced By: Senate President Stephen Luke

Summary:

This bill introduces to Parliament, a law that would require only armed organizations to register their status and weapons with the Department of Justice. These groups include but are not limited to shooting clubs and non-governmental militias. This bill was introduced due to the previous civil war of Dracul, which resulted in multiple individuals banding together to create an armed organization and attacking Dracul armed forces. The weapons owned by this organization were not registered with the government and the armed forces were unaware of the amount of firepower to expect in combat. This bill does not affect private citizens and their ownership of weapons.

Proposal:

- 1. Require all organizations who intend on owning firearms to register with the Justice Dept.
- 2. Require members of such organizations to consent to background checks with law enforcement.
- 3. Restrict organizations from owning more than 10 long arms and 5 handguns at a time.
- 4. Require all members of these organization to attend firearm safety courses
- 5. Require any organization who wishes to hold more than 15 firearms to apply for a special license with any required stipulations to be decided on a case to case basis.
- 6. Prosecute organizations and members through Justice Dept, who violate proposed bill.
- 7. Limit possession of organization's owned weapons to 2 per person, per private organization
