The Facts Don't Support Gasification

Global Environmental Infrastructure Technology Solutions (GEITS) is proposing a gasification staged incinerator for the Village of Mukwonago at a potential new industrial park on STH 83 south of I43.

GEITS proposed a similar project in the City of Adams, WI See – Attached "Facts on Gasification" and "Plans for a gasification incinerator surface in Adams, WI" at www.weal.org

There are no commercial scale gasification staged incinerators using municipal solid waste (MSW) as feedstock in the United States.

In other countries, Gasification projects have failed due to excessive emissions, operational problems and financial losses.

Gasification staged incinerators release polluting ultra-fine particulate air emissions.

Gasification destroys valuable resources since recyclable materials like plastics; paper and cardboard are the desired feedstock.

Gasification staged incinerators are expensive and are actually a waste-of-energy.

A pyrolysis staged incinerator project planned in Green Bay received millions in federal funding but never built due to a permit being revoked.
