



Capital Campaign

The Diocese has launched a capital campaign that requires all parishes in the diocese to participate.



Some 21 parishes were selected

by the campaign office to be the initial pilot phase parishes which began last year and are soon ending their pilot phase/stage.

Our Parishes (St. Joseph and St. Ladislaus) together with all the remaining parishes of the Diocese, form the Block I Parishes for the next phase/stage.

The Goal/Quota assigned to St. Joseph, Galloway is \$120,000.

65% (\$78,000) is going to be made available to St. Joseph, Galloway for our major improvements, renovations and on-going maintenance cost.

35% (\$42,000) which includes the 2022-2023 Diocesan Annual Appeal will be used by the Diocese for improvements of the Holy Cross Diocesan Center, including "fortifying the future" of the Diocese, the Catholic Foundation of West Central Wisconsin.

The campaign stretches over a 5-year period, allowing parishioners to make their contributions/donations over this time.

The theme of the campaign is "Inspired by the Spirit" and I would suggest each of you, kindly, seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit in making your decision as to the amount to donate to this campaign.

Reflections: Salvation

Question: In some passages of the Bible, Jesus makes it sound like only a few people will be saved. But we talk about hoping for everyone's salvation. So which one is it — will many or few people be saved?

Answer: Salvation is a mystery of God's grace. St. Paul encourages us to offer prayers for everyone. He calls it "good and pleasing to God" because God Himself "wills everyone to be saved" (c.f. 1 Tm 2:1-4). The redemption that Jesus offers is held out to all of us. His sacrifice on the cross was already for everyone. Now it is a matter of if and how we accept that salvation in our own lives.

Here on earth, we can't possibly know the exact number of people who will be in heaven. When we hear words like "many" and "few," we tend to think of them in quantitative terms. Four wine glasses for six guests is too few. Three slices of cake for one person is too many. For God, however, "many" and "few" are qualitative terms. Imagine for a moment that nearly every human person is in heaven and only a handful had, by their actions on earth, separated themselves from God. For a God who infinitely loves, even one person spending eternity apart from Him is too many! ©LPi
