SUBJECT: **MECHANICS FOR THE DIVISION MATHEMATICS COMPETITION**

DATE: September 23, 2016

1. Oral Competition
 - a. The Mathematics Supervisor shall be responsible for selecting questions submitted by the different districts. The consolidated questions shall be given during the contest.
 - b. There shall be 20 questions: It shall be composed of 10 easy; 5 average; and 5 difficult.
 - b.1. The easy questions shall be given a time slot of 15 seconds per question worth 2 points each. The questions shall be answered mentally. There will be no writing anywhere, neither on paper, the table, etc. The team of two shall work together as one to discuss their answer to the question. They may start discussing their solution after the reading of the questions.
 - b.2. The average questions worth 3 points each shall be given a time slot of 30 seconds. The contestants shall be provided with scratch paper. They may begin solving as soon as they wish.
 - b.3. The difficult questions worth 5 points shall be given a time slot of 60 seconds(1 minute). A copy of the questions shall be provided for each contestant. Scratch paper will be provided.
2. The Quizmaster will read each question twice, after which he/she gives the Go signal. The timing starts when the quizmaster gives the Go signal.
3. As soon as the buzzer rings, everybody must stop writing.
4. Answers must be given complete with units and to the required accuracy. However if the unit is already given in the way the question is asked, it need not be given in the answer.
5. In case of a tie among any of the teams vying for the first three, a set of 3 questions will be given to break the tie, one from each category of questions. If the tie is not broken after the three questions, "do or die" questions will be given.
6. Only official contestants may raise a complaint or clarification.
7. Complaints on a given question should be made before the next question is asked. This should be directed to the Quizmaster.
8. The competition shall require the following support personnel for elementary and Secondary: (2) Timers, (2) Quizmasters, (2) Recorders.
9. The consolidated result of District Math Competition should be submitted to the Mathematics Supervisor before the Division Competitions.
