- Other Expenses \$30,449
 - o Vet services (other than Hope Fund and spay/neuter) \$3,562
 - Vetting providing before Hope Fund or spay/neuter programs were established
 - o Rescue pull fees \$7,927
 - Fees rescues pay shelters, like LMAS, to "pull" a pet out of the shelter – paid out for both local and out-of-state rescues
 - o Animal Supplies (general needs shelters and rescues) \$906
 - o Transports (gas, tolls) \$695
 - o Repairs and maintenance (pet food bank) \$119
 - o Advertising (pet promotion; events; angel tree program, etc) \$5,100
 - o Printing, postage, shipping \$643
 - o Conferences (Rescue Waggin' training and no kill conf) \$2,773
 - o Insurance (board and event) \$1,844
 - o Administrative (approximately .4% of gross receipts) \$408
 - o Office \$6,472
 - Includes 501(c)3 fees (\$408); bank fees (\$171); phone charges (\$634): PayPal fees (\$2,597); and misc. supplies (\$1,585)
