On the day before your colonoscop

What You CAN eat or drink:

- You may drink clear liquids only, including:
 - Water
 - · Clear fruit juices without pulp including apple, white grape, or white cranberry
 - Strained limeade or lemonade
 - · Coffee or tea (Do not use any diary or non-dairy creamer)
 - · Clear broth
 - · Clear soda
- You may eat the following:
 - · Gelatin (without added fruit or topping)
 - · Popsicles without pieces of fruit or fruit pulp

What You CANNOT eat or drink:

- DO NOT eat solid foods or drink milk.
- DO NOT eat or drink anything colored red or purple.
- · DO NOT drink alcohol.
- * IMPORTANT: Do not take other laxatives while taking Suclear

PLEASE NOTE:

- Suclear is indicated for the cleansing of the colon as a preparation for colonoscopy in adults.
- Be sure to tell your doctor about all the medicines you take, including prescription and non-prescription medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements. Suclear may affect how other medicines work.
- Medication taken by mouth may not be absorbed properly when taken within 1 hour before the start
 of each dose of Suclear.
- The most common adverse reactions after administration of Suclear were overall discomfort, abdominal distention, abdominal pain, nausea, vomiting, and headache.

Your Suclear bowel prep kit should include the following:

- · One 6-ounce bottle of oral solution
- One 16-ounce mixing container
- One 2-liter bottle with white powder for oral solution
- Four flavor packs in Pineapple, Lemon-Lime, Orange, and Cherry
- Instructions for Use booklet with Full Prescribing Information, Medication Guide, and Instructions for Use
