You foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly exhibited as crucified! ²The only thing I want to learn from you is this: Did you receive the Spirit by doing the works of the law or by believing what you heard? ³Are you so foolish? Having started with the Spirit, are you now ending with the

flesh? ⁴Did you experience so much for nothing?—if it really was for nothing. ⁵Well then, does God supply you with the Spirit and work miracles among you by your doing the works of the law, or by your believing what you heard? ⁶Just as Abraham "believed God, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness," ⁷so, you see, those

- who believe are the descendants of Abraham. ⁸And the scripture,
- foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, declared the gospel
- beforehand to Abraham, saying, "All
- the Gentiles shall be blessed in you."
- ⁹For this reason, those who believe are
- blessed with Abraham who believed.
- ²³Now before faith came, we were

imprisoned and guarded under the law until faith would be revealed.

²⁴Therefore the law was our

- disciplinarian until Christ came, so that
- we might be justified by faith. ²⁵But now
- that faith has come, we are no longer
- subject to a disciplinarian, ²⁶for in
- Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith. ²⁷As many of you as were

baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. ²⁸There is no longer Jew or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to the promise.
